

## ORDER

Whereas in terms of rules 3(2), 6(2A) and 6(5) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Rules, 1964, terms & conditions and procedure for making the use of land in shamilat deh for Gaushala, lease of land for setting Gaushala and for growing fodder by Gaushala have been prescribed, vide instructions issued vide letter No.SBA-4/2019/7500-7521 dated 04.02.2019. It has also been specified that the applications for lease of land for setting up Gaushala shall be scrutinized by a committee comprising following officers :-

1. Deputy Commissioner	Chairman
2. President Zila Parishad	Member
3. Additional Deputy Commissioner	Member
4. District Development & Panchayats Officer	Member
5. District Revenue Officer ;and	Member
6. Deputy Director Animal Husbandry-cum-District Gauvansh Vikas Adhikari	Member

Further whereas, in pursuance of instructions dated 04.02.2019, to make the functions more explicit in terms of 3(2), 6(2A) and 6(5) of the PVCL Rules, the Terms of Reference of the above-stated Committee shall be as under:-

1. In case, the Gram Panchayat makes the use of its land for setting up Gaushala through another as per provision under 3(2)(ii-a) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Rules, 1964 the manner of selecting the agency/society/trust and other terms and conditions shall be approved by the Committee.
2. In case of lease of land for Gaushalas, after a resolution passed by Gram Panchayat and Gram Sabha for lease of land for setting up Gaushala in the village, the Committee shall ensure that an advertisement is made to invite applications from intended bidders. The applications so received shall be scrutinized by the Committee and shall make it's recommendation for approval of the Government.
3. The proposal for lease of land in shamilat deh for fodder shall be examined and recommended by the Committee to the Director Panchayats for it's approval and after approval, the antecedents of the intended bidders shall also be verified and finalized by this committee.
4. The working of Gaushalas shall be monitored regularly by the committee and ensure that the terms and conditions of the agreement are being abided by.
5. Any other matter or proposal relating or connected to the above references, as the Deputy Commissioner deem fit.


