Proceedings of the Minutes of VC Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Sh. Dhirendra Khadgata. IAS. Director. Development and Panchayats on 23rd June 2022 at 03.30 PM onwards in his office room at Haryana Panchayat Bhawan, Sector-28, Chandigarh

A VC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of worthy Director, Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana on 23rd June 2022 at 03.30 PM at Haryana Panchayat Bhawan to review progress of eGramSwaraj and Gram Darshan portal.

During the VC, following decisions were taken:

1. Appreciation letter shall be issued to CEOs, Zila Parishad of top 5 performing districts (i.e. Faridabad, Jind, Nuh, Panchkula and Panipat) in eGramSwaraj Portal and displeasure note shall be issued to CEO ZP of worst 5 performing districts (i.e. Sonipat, Hisar, Jhajjar, Palwal and Charkhi Dadri).
2. All the CEOs, Zila Parishad were directed to adhere to the timelines for implementation of all the State/Central schemes.
3. All the CEOs, Zila Parishad were directed to get the yearbook closure for FY 2021-22 and ensure preparation of development plans of their Zila Parishads and all Panchayat Samitis & Gram Panchayats in eGram Swaraj portal within next 7 days.
4. Pendency in Gram Darshan portal should be removed within one month.
5. Funds under 15th Finance Commission, State Finance Commission, Own Resources including fixed deposits should be used to execute the works.
6. Priority should be given to the demands of Gram Darshan Portal.
7. Demands received in gram Darshan portal shall be included in GPDP.
8. Admin approval of the feasible works shall be sought from the CEO ZP.
9. CM Announcements shall not be part of Gram Darshan portal.
10. Demands related to Aanganwaris, roads constructed by marketing board, bus queue shelters and PHCs should be sent to State HQ as its funds are provided by concerned departments.
11. Gram Darshan portal should be reviewed with concerned DPMs and suggestions to improve its functionality (if any) can be submitted to w/DP in whatsapp group.
12. Financial powers of DDPO, Palwal shall be allowed to Smt. Upma Arora, who is holding additional charge of DDPO, Palwal.

13. Performance report of divisional consultants of KPMG shall be sought from all the CEOs, Zila Parishad and AE (IT) shall circulate its format to all.
14. Development and Panchayats Minister has sought report on door-to-door collection from all the Districts.
15. Pending UCs should be submitted to State HQ at the earliest before 30th June in coordination with Accounts Officer ZP.
16. Amrit Sarovar Ponds and Grey Water Management related projects UCs should be submitted soon in coordination with concerned XENs (PR).
17. 4 Districts under IWMP were given funds, whose UCs is still pending and it needs to be submitted to State HQ before 30th June.
18. Survey activity under Rural Asset Directory should be got completed by concerned DDPOs at the earliest.
19. Land shall be identified for construction of BDPO Offices and residential colonies for BDPOs/XENs, whose funds would be released from State HQ.
