Section 3: INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

1. BACKGROUND

One of the key responsibilities of Development & Panchayats Department, Haryana is to ensure sanitation and solid & liquid waste management in rural areas of Haryana. Swachh Bharat Mission (“SBM”) - Gramin program was launched by the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India, to undertake reforms and facilitate investments in the rural sector. Solid Waste Management (SWM) is the priority area of the department and is making continued efforts in improving SWM in Haryana for the past few years.

The Department intends to create socially, economically, and environmentally viable waste management system through developing an environmentally and aesthetically sound project in 143 blocks in rural areas of Haryana in order to reuse and recycle the construction & demolition of solid waste. The proposed project is intended to have a positive impact in the rural areas of Haryana while at the same time create as benchmark in the country. This vision of recycling of C&D waste into useful products can have a huge impact of all the people living in the Gram Panchayats and people who are directly or indirectly associated with the project.

Construction and demolition waste is generated whenever any construction/demolition activity takes place, such as, building roads, bridges, houses, renovating houses etc. With the growing population and the demand of new houses and living spaces, the construction activities are at full swing. With this there is wastage and good amount of C&D waste generating on daily basis. This mostly comprises of inert and non-biodegradable material such as concrete, plaster, metal, wood, plastics etc. While retrievable items such as bricks, wood, metal, tiles can be recycled, the concrete and masonry waste, accounting for more than 50% of the waste from construction and demolition activities, are not being currently recycled in India. Concrete and masonry waste can be recycled by sorting, crushing and sieving into recycled aggregate. This recycled aggregate can be used to make concrete for road construction and building material

In light of the above, Department has prepared this “Expression of Interest” for undertaking collection, storage and recycling of Construction & Demolition (C&D) Waste in rural areas of Haryana wherein Block wise details has been provided at Annexure -1 for understanding. Applicants are advised to verify all the details themselves before submitting their responses.

2. EOI Processing Fees

No fees to be paid by applicants for submitting the EOI responses. Department reserves the right to initiate next process for selection of Bidder for the Project or cancel the entire process without quoting any specific reasons at any stage.

3. Documents to be submitted

All information and responses under this EOI is to be submitted online mode only through e-tender portal i.e. <https://etenders.hry.nic.in/> covering the below mentioned details:

1. Applicant’s Expression of Interest as per Format
2. Organization and Contact Details as per Format
3. Experience of the organization as per Format
4. Declaration of not being black-listed as per Format
5. Methodology/ Process details or Technology descriptions of the project
6. Client references and contact details (email/ landline/ mobile) of customers for whom the Applicant has supplied similar products.

4. Selection Process

The EOI is issued only with a purpose of identifying experienced parties and their intent to take-up the project and Department reserves the right to proceed ahead with the project. However, the applications received shall be reviewed carefully and if required, interactions will be likely scheduled and held before finalization of project scope, terms and conditions. Based on the outcomes of the interactions, request for Proposal shall be issued for each individual block. An interaction meeting/presentation would be organized by the Department where applicants will be required to present their approach on execution of the above-mentioned project.

5. Eligibility of Applicant

The applicant can be Sole Proprietor/ Company/ Partnership/ NGOs/ Trusts/SHGs registered under Companies Act 2013 or 1956/ Public Limited Company/ Private Limited Company (wherever required) with at least 1 year of experience in collection, storage, reuse, recycling, of Construction & Demolition waste (Copy of the Order/ MoU/evidence of managing and dispose Waste from any ULB/Authority/CSR) . The applicant can submit a copy of Certificate of trusts/societies Act/ Copy of the Partnership deed/ Bye Law/Certificate of Incorporation issued by Registrar of Companies along with Memorandum & Articles of Association and full address of the registered office, whichever applicable.

Applicants must submit duly filled and signed by authorized signatory - Form 2 and Form 3 as mentioned under section 4.

6. Scope of Work

The scope of work for each individual block for the project has been mentioned below:

- Utilize construction and demolition waste by either recycling and preparing paver blocks, applying lower layers of road pavements in colonies and rural roads. (In case the applicant proposes new technology to recycle, then they must submit it in their Approach & Methodology).
- Arrange to provide appropriate number of skip containers/tractor- trolleys required to undertake the project for a particular block.
- For small C&D waste generators of e.g., petty repair/maintenance job, there may be two options – (i) specific places for recycling be set up by selected agency and (ii) collection and removal of C&D waste from specified areas on payment basis.
- In case of small villages where skips or tractor trolleys are not available, manual loading and unloading should be conducted by using appropriate manpower.
- In case, the applicant requires land outside the vicinity of the village, then the department will provide suitable sites for setting up of plant specifically for the purpose of C& D waste on Lease basis.

Recycling And Reuse

The use of C&D waste materials basically depends on their separation and condition of the separated material. A majority of these materials are durable and therefore, have a high potential of reuse. It would, however, be desirable to have quality standards for the recycled materials. Construction and demolition waste can be used in the following manner:

- Reuse (at site) of bricks, stone slabs, timber, conduits, piping railings etc. to the extent possible and depending upon their condition.
- Sale / auction of material which cannot be used at the site due to design constraint or change in design.
 - Plastics, broken glass, scrap metal etc. can be used by recycling industries.
 - Rubble, brick bats, broken plaster/concrete pieces etc. can be used for building activity, such as, leveling, under coat of lanes where the traffic does not constitute of heavy moving loads.
 - Larger unusable pieces can be sent for filling up low-lying areas.
 - Fine material, such as, sand, dust etc. can be used as cover material over sanitary landfill.
- The processing / recycling site shall be away from habitation clusters, forest areas, water bodies, monuments, National Parks, Wetlands and places of important cultural, historical or religious interest.

7. Submission of EOI:

- i. Applicants are advised to study all instructions, forms, terms, requirements and other information in the EOI carefully.
- ii. Applicants are advised to undertake site visits and may provide their suggestions for successful implementation of the project.
- iii. Applicants shall be deemed to have applied after careful examination of the EOI documents with full understanding of its implication.
- iv. The response to this EOI should be full and complete in all respects. Failure to furnish all information required by the EOI or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to the EOI in every respect will be at applicants' risk and may result in rejection of its eligibility.
